Deer Lodge Medical Center Temporary Visitation Restrictions

The well-being of our patients and caregivers is our top priority, especially during this time. With COVID-19 circulating in our communities, Deer Lodge Medical Center is taking steps to ensure the safety of our patients and our facility as we provide care to our patients.

The following visitor restrictions will apply beginning Friday, March 20. Please follow posted signage and directives from on-site Deer Lodge Medical Center employees.

Visitation Restrictions:

TCU/Inpatient:

To limit the spread of infectious illnesses, in-person visits will not be allowed. We encourage patients and their families to communicate through phone and video chat. Exceptions may be made on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the nursing director or hospitalist for the following:

- End of Life Care
- Children Admitted to the Hospital

In those cases, visitors will be limited to the spouse, parent/guardian, child or primary caregiver and will be required to remain in the patient room at all times.

Emergency Department:

Patients can have one essential visitor. An essential visitor is defined as a spouse, Power of Attorney, Guardian, Parent, or Caregiver.

Outpatient Clinics:

(including Physical Therapy, Cardiac Rehab, DL Clinic)

Patients can have one essential visitor defined as: Spouse, Parent/Guardian or Caregiver.
